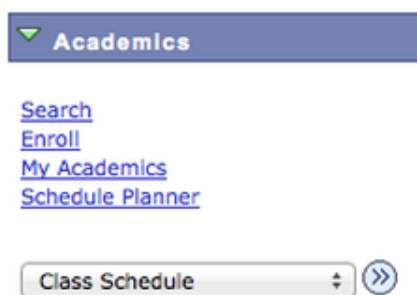


FINDING YOUR EXAM TIME IN MATH 1132

Everyone was supposed to pick an exam time, 6 to 8 PM or 9 to 11 PM, when registering. **You must take the exam at the time that you picked.** How can you find that time?

Step 1. Go into Peoplesoft: from <https://student.studentadmin.uconn.edu/>, click on the Login button under “Students, Instructors, Advisors.”

Step 2. View class schedule in Peoplesoft: go to Student Center and click on “Enroll” in the upper left corner. Then click on “Class Schedule” under “Academics” as shown below.



Select **Spring 2016** as the schedule you want to view.

Step 3. Find exam time: use the class schedule filter option near the top to show only *enrolled* classes, and scroll down to Math 1132. In the (2nd) “Section” column, the exam section ends in EX. See the screenshots below (01EX and 02EX). The exam time is listed as either Th 6:00 PM - 8:00PM or Th 9:00 PM - 11:00 PM.
