Group Work on Exponential Growth: The Black Bear Population

Exponential Growth Model

$$P(t) = P_0 e^{kt}$$

where:

t = time (in units of time)

k = the exponential growth rate (a constant fraction)

$e = 2.7$ (approximately)

P_0 = population's size at time $t = 0$ (the time when the counting started)

$P(t)$ = population's size at time t

In 1999 the black bear population in Granite Park was 325 and the exponential growth rate of the black bear population was 5% per year.
